



## *Book Bytes in Mathematics*



### *Recommendation for In-Service Credit*

The following criteria must be met to be recommended to receive in-service credit:

1. Log into the class at least three times a week during the duration of the course. (Sign-in statistics are tracked by the system.)
2. All assignments are to be submitted by 11:59:59 p.m. of the due date. Late assignments will be posted in the 'I'm Late, I'm Late for a Very Important Date' forum and must be submitted within one week of the due date.
3. All assignments are to meet Acceptable or Exceptional standards as set forth in the rubrics. Assignments may be resubmitted until they meet the Acceptable or Exceptional standard.
4. In group assignments/activities, participation is imperative. (Discussions in Chat Rooms are archived and can be viewed by the instructor.)
5. At all times professional discourse among participants and 'netiquette' are to be observed.

The final outcome of Books and Bytes in Mathematics is a mini-unit integrating the internet with a specific picture book to support New York State's Mathematical Key Idea(s). This project will be the result of readings, searches, and discussions. Participants will also have amassed a collection of skills and strategies to apply to other picture books.
