

Creating Differentiated Math Lessons for Elementary Education **(Sloan – 15 hours)**

Policies

1. All participants are expected to sign in at least three days a week. A week runs from Monday through Sunday.
2. All participants must fully participate in the entire course. Active participation and well thought-out assignments are necessary in order to be successful in this course. You are responsible for responding to all assignments and to other participants in order to receive full credit.
