Course Credit Policies, Science Projects on the Internet Grades 3-5:

Upon satisfactory completion of this 15 hour Online Course: Science Projects on the Internet, Grades 3-5, participants will be recommended for 1 district in-service credit.

To complete the course, participants will be expected to sign into the course for updates, responses to postings, etc., at least three times each week the course runs. (Sign-in statistics are tracked over the period the course is run.)

Participants will be expected to complete all assignments and activities at the level of "competent" as per course rubrics for each activity/assignment, and within time frames given. (Please note that activities/assignments may be resubmitted during an interactive feedback process.)

Professional discourse among participants is a course expectation. Group interaction and participant response and feedback is an integral part of course activities and outcome.

Each course week will run from Tuesday to Tuesday. Assignments and are due by midnight of the due date, usually Monday night, at midnight. The assignments will be accessed through the Assign button.

Resources will be added to course items as the course progresses, and participants are encouraged to check the web resources item for supporting material on a regular basis.

Final outcome of Science Projects on the Internet, Grades 3-5 is an Internet science project, designed for immediate use at each participant's particular grade level. This project will be the result of course activities involving reading, research, searching, group collaboration and feedback, and the application of assessment rubrics. And NYS standards.

This course requires 15 hours of online activity, in addition to time required to complete the project product.
