Policy Overview

Lateness

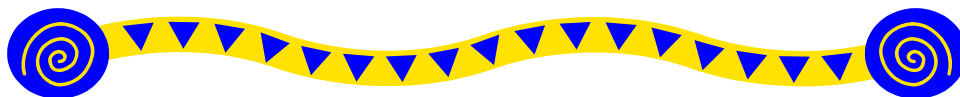
- 1) Late assignments and postings will lose 25% of their seat time equivalent for every day late.
